AAC ID CARDS:

If your dog does not have a completed AAC card, please order it well in advance (form enclosed) from AAC (www.aac.ca). You must have your dog measured and your card marked with that measurement before checking-in.

CRATING AND SET-UP: There is ample space for crating inside. Please do not block scoreboards, doorways, walkways etc. Please be aware that leaving valuables on-site overnight is at the risk of the owner.

CLASS CHANGE/MOVE-UPS:

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the dog entered hereon. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) have read, understand and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada, Inc. in effect at the time of this entry, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the Agility Trial Schedule for this event. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and General Agreement/Disclaimer. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with such Official Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made in accordance with them.

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the host club has the right to refuse my entry for causes, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged:

I/We agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada, sponsors of the event, owner of the premises upon which the event is being held and their employees, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

CAMPING:

On site camping is available at a rate of \$23.50/night (incl. power) paid in advance. Please send in with your entry and make a note of your license plate # and what nights. No washrooms available at night, as the building will be locked, so self-contained vehicles only. **If you decided to pay your camping fees at the trial the Agriplex will collect \$26+gst camping fees.**

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO CLOVERDALE AGRIPLEX:

From Hwy-99, take #10 hwy exit. Follow #10 hwy to 176th. Turn left to 62nd Ave. Fairgrounds will be on your right.

From Hwy-1, take 176th Exit (Cloverdale) south to 62nd Ave. You will see signs for the Cloverdale Agriplex (Fairgrounds), on your left. There is plenty of parking outside the building.

REMINDERS TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may effect the dog's physical or mental performance, or any dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including during familiarization and course-walking. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.
- Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great new venue available to us and other dog clubs!
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made.
- If an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.
- There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.
