TRIAL SITE: This trial will be held outdoors on a grass surface. Rain or Shine.

CONCESSION: Rotary Stadium & Lori's Donair. There are nearby restaurants.

EQUIPMENT & FAMILIARIZATION: We will be using electronic timing & break-a-way tires and rubberized contact equipment in both rings. **Equipment familiarization for Starters dogs only; Contact equipment only.**

AAC ID CARDS: If your dog does not have a completed AAC card, please order it well in advance (form enclosed) from AAC (www.aac.ca). You must have your dog measured and your card marked with that measurement before checking-in.

CRATING AND SET-UP: There will be plenty of space for set up of shade tents etc. Please be aware that leaving valuables on-site overnight is at the risk of the owner.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Flat ribbons will be available for 1st - 4th place. All Qualifying runs will receive an official Qualifying Rosette. Rosettes will be given for Steeplechase title, as well as Expert and Versatility Titles. Teams who earn the following titles Bronze, Silver & Gold Awards of Merit will receive special ribbons.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: Give us a hand setting poles, building courses, straightening chutes, running leashes or scribe sheets.

CONFIRMATION: Will be emailed, if no email address is provided your confirmation will be done by phone. If you do not receive a confirmation by the Sunday prior to the trial date, or if there are errors, please notify the Trial Secretary ASAP. This will help avoid delays on the day of the trial.

TRIAL RESULTS: Trial results will be posted on the K9 Cliffhanger website: www.k9cliffhangers.ca shortly after the completion of the trial.

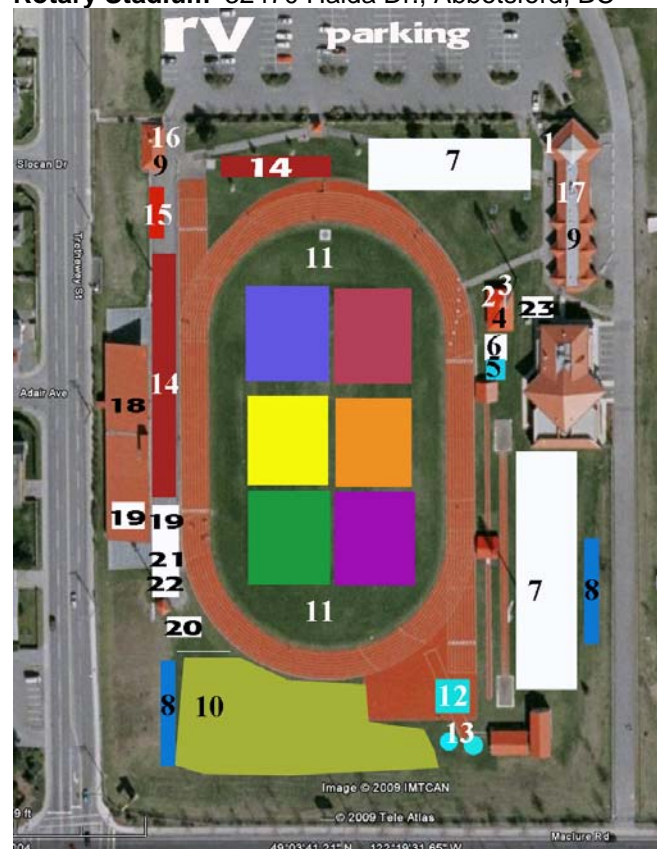

Driving Directions:

Coming from the West (Lower Mainland, Van. Island)

- Head east on HWY 1.
- Take Exit 83, Mt. Lehman Rd.
- Keep left at fork to merge onto Maclure Road.
- Turn left at Trethewey.
- Continue onto Haida Drive. Destination is on your right.

Coming from the East (Interior)

- Head west on HWY 1.
- Take Exit 90 for McCallum Rd.
- Turn left at S Fraser Way
- Turn right at Trethewey.
- Continue onto Haida Drive. Destination is on your right.

[The K9 Cliffhangers](#) are hosting two AAC sanctioned Steeplechase events on the Friday, June 11th, 2010th of the 10th Annual 2010 BC/Yukon Regional Championships.

- Each Steeplechase run is \$15 each to enter
- Both Steeplechase runs are open to anyone who meets AAC eligibility requirements (the dog does not have to be entered into the BCY 2010 Regional Competition to enter the Steeplechase events - including the Sunday run-off, should they qualify).
- You will be able to earn an AAC Qualifying score in each class, provided you are under the Judge's SCT based on AAC Steeplechase time plus faults scoring.
- Placement and Qualifier ribbons will be awarded

On Sunday, after all regional events are complete, the K9 Cliffhangers & the BCY 2010 Regionals Committee will host a Steeplechase Run-Off (non-sanctioned) based on the results from the two steeplechase events on Friday.

To qualify for the money round on Sunday, you need to finish in the top 20% of your class of either of Friday's courses, whether you qualified for AAC purposes or not. If you finish in the top 20% in both Friday's runs, you still only get one chance to run on Sunday, but you have reduced the number of competitors you will be running against by keeping another dog out of that spot.

4 JACKPOT \$\$ ROUNDS

The dog with the best time in the following classes on Sunday will win the cash award (we have combined classes in this manner to make larger jackpots, but to try and keep it somewhat fair for each height, ie double drop 10 inch vets will not compete against 6 inch single drop vets):

- 6" spec/vets; 6 " vets (double drop); 10' spec/vets (single drop)
- 10" vets (double drop); 16" vets (double drop); 16 inch spec/vets; 22 inch spec/vets
- 10" regular/16" regular
- 22" regular /26 " regular

There is no fee to enter the run-off round (but it is only open to those who are invited to run based on Friday's results). Qualifiers list for the Sunday event will be announced Sunday morning all handlers meeting.

The [The K9 Cliffhangers](#) will donate the Net proceeds from the Friday Steeplechase rounds towards the Jackpot cash awards. These amounts will be announced after registration closes and the number of entries is set. Look forward to some large jackpots depending on the number of dogs who enter the Friday events!

Other prizes or cash maybe donated by sponsors to add to the overall Jackpot. [Happy Dog Raw Dog Food](#) has already donated HDRaw food to each winner and money to the jackpot.

REMINDERS TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may effect the dog's physical or mental performance, or any dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including during familiarization and course-walking. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.
- Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great new venue available to us and other dog clubs!
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made.
- If an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.
- There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the host club has the right to refuse my entry for causes, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged:

I/We agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada, sponsors of the event, owner of the premises upon which the event is being held and their employees, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from claims of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, death or otherwise be caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by negligence of any person, or any cause or causes.
